

## Equipment List for Aspiring Cook Combo - 10 days

Throughout the summer season, a full range of conditions and temperatures can be expected on ascents of Mt Aspiring and Aoraki / Mt Cook and clients need to be suitably prepared. Your guide will do a comprehensive gear check at your pre-trip meeting. Mt Aspiring is a fly-in and walk out trip based at Colin Todd hut and you will need to carry your personal gear and will be asked to assist in carrying some group equipment and food from the heli landing site to the hut and on the walk out. Aoraki / Mt Cook is a fly-in and out trip based at Plateau Hut and a duffel bag of overnight gear can be taken to the hut. On the summit day you will need to carry your personal gear and may be asked to assist in carrying some group gear.

### Personal Equipment Checklist

#### COMPULSORY - These items will definitely be required

##### Body

- Underwear
- Base layer (150-190g weight, merino or polypop, no cotton)
  - top
  - leggings
- Mid layer top (fleece or windproof)
- Insulating jacket (fleece or synthetic fill)
- Waterproof jacket (eg Gore Tex® or similar)
- Overpants\*** (as above)
- Lightweight, quick drying trousers
- Collared glacier/trekking shirt

##### Feet

- Mountaineering boots Full shank, 3 season (eg La Sportiva® Nepal)\***
- Ankle gaiters\***
- 2 pairs of trekking socks

##### Head/Face

- Sunhat - cap
- Warm hat & neck gaiter (eg Buff®)
- Sunglasses - glacier rated category 4

##### Hands

- Warm windproof gloves
- Light gloves

##### Technical equipment (supplied FOC)

- Climbing helmet
- Crampons - with anti-balling plates
- Ice axe
- Ice hammer
- Climbing harness
- Belay device
- Sling - nylon or Dyneema®, 120cm
- 4x Carabiners - HMS preferred
- 2x 6mm Prusiks - 1x60cm, 1x 120cm loop length
- Ice screw

##### Accessories

- Backpack (40+ litres)\***
- Sleeping bag (2 season, 0°C) & liner\***
- Water bottles - 2 litres capacity
- Head torch - and spare batteries
- Toiletries - blister kit & personal medication
- Small container of sunblock & lip screen

##### OPTIONAL - Personal preference items

- Collapsible trekking poles\***
- Camera
- Swiss army knife or leatherman
- Earplugs for sleeping
- Lightweight approach/hut shoes (eg Crocs®)
- USB charging for small electronic devices available in Plateau Hut

#### TRIP DEPENDANT - Depends on weather and condition factors

If you have these items, please bring them along if it is not a hassle. Your guide will discuss if these items are required during the pre-trip meeting and they can be hired or purchased in Wanaka if required.
