

Equipment List for Mountaineering Summit trips - 5-8 days

Throughout the summer season, a full range of conditions and temperatures can be expected on an ascent in the Southern Alps. Due to the remote nature of the mountains, clients need to be suitably prepared. Your guide will do a comprehensive gear check at your pre-trip meeting. This is usually a fly-in, fly-out trip with access to the hut being a short walk from the heli landing. You will need to carry your personal gear and will be asked to assist in carrying some food and group equipment from the heli-landing site to the hut.
