

Equipment List for Summit to Sea Tour - 5 days

Throughout the winter season, a full range of conditions and temperatures can be expected in the mountains. Due to variable nature of conditions, clients need to be suitably prepared. Your guide will do a comprehensive gear check at your pre-trip meeting. This is a fly-in and out trip based out of high mountain huts on either the Fox, Franz Josef or Tasman glaciers. These huts are stocked with mattresses and some cooking equipment. If skiing down to a lower hut for a pick-up, you will need to carry your personal gear and will be asked to assist in carrying some items of group equipment and food.

Personal Equipment Checklist

COMPULSORY - These items will definitely be required

Body

- Underwear
- Base layer (150-190g weight, merino or polypop, no cotton)
 - top
 - leggings
- Mid layer top (fleece or windproof)
- Insulating jacket (fleece or synthetic fill)
- Waterproof jacket (eg Gore Tex® or similar)
- Overpants*** (as above)
- Softshell ski/snowboard trousers

Feet

- Ski or snowboard boots*** (See note below, available for hire from [MT Outdoors](#))
- 2 pairs of ski socks

Head/Face

- Sunhat - cap
- Warm hat & neck gaiter (eg Buff®)
- Sunglasses - category 3 or 4 preferable
- Snow goggles***

Hands

- Warm windproof gloves
- Light gloves

OPTIONAL - Personal preference items

- Ski or climbing helmet (climbing helmet available FOC)
- Camera
- Swiss army knife or leatherman
- Map, compass and compact notebook and pencil
- Crevasse rescue kit - pulley or progress capture device (eg Petzl Micro Traxion®)
- Lightweight hut shoes (eg Crocs®)
- Earplugs for sleeping

Ski or Snowboard Equipment - See note below (available for hire from [MT Outdoors](#))

- Ski touring skis, bindings, skins, ski crampons & poles* or**
- Splitboard, skins, splitboard crampons & collapsible poles***

Technical equipment (supplied FOC)

- Crampons - with anti-balling plates
- Ice axe
- Harness
- Belay device
- Sling - nylon or Dyneema®, 120cm
- 4x Carabiners - HMS preferred
- 2x 6mm Prusiks - 1x60cm, 1x 120cm loop length
- Ice screw

Accessories

- Backpack (40+ litres) - with straps to carry skis or snowboard***
- Avalanche transceiver/shovel/probe***
- Sleeping bag and liner***
- Water bottles - 2 litres capacity
- Head torch - and spare batteries
- Toiletries - blister kit & personal medication
- Small container of sunblock & lip screen

TRIP DEPENDANT - Depends on weather and condition factors

- For nights in town/travelling - towel and change of clothes
